H.E THE PRESIDENT DR.WILLIAM SAMOEI RUTO COMMISSIONS MAVOKO DRINKING WATER SUPPLY PROJECT ON 14TH.APRIL 2023.

Mavoko Drinking Water Supply Project was commissioned on 14th April 2023 by H.E the President Dr. William Samoei Ruto. The Government of Kenya through Tanathi Water Works Development Agency has been implementing the project funded by the Government of Kenya and Belfius Bank of Belgium. The total cost for the project is Ksh 2.7 Billion. The scope of works entails rehabilitation of KMC and EAPCC dams for water supply development and rehabilitated Nol-Turesh line and constructed an independent Nairobi line for additional water to Mavoko.

The Project is a Flagship Program under Vision 2030 of the Government of Kenya (GOK). On completion the project Tanathi Water Works Development Agency handed over the project to Machokos County Government to be operated by Mavoko Water Service Provider which supplies water to Mavoko Sub - County and its environs.

The project main achievement is to increase service delivery from 3 hours to 24 hours by increasing the treated water supply from 3,000m³/day to 12,000m³/day. The existing connections were 9,500. The connections have increased to 20,000 (500,000 people). This is a mix of domestic, commercial, institutional and Industrial. The project has a Last Mile component and already provides treated water to approximately 500,000 residents in a mix of domestic, commercial and industrial thus contributing to manufacturing, affordable housing and Universal Health Care by reducing waterborne diseases. Areas of coverage include: Mlolongo, Athi River, EPZA zone, Syokimau, Kinanie, Katani and parts of Lukenya urban centers.

The project has created a positive impact in the social and economic lives of the local community where livelihoods have improved arising from approximately 300 temporary jobs that were created during the course of the project implementation which accounts to over 98% of the labour force required for construction of the entire project was sourced locally.
